Sophia, developed by Hanson Robotics, is an advanced humanoid robot (18) . She serves as both a science fiction character and a platform for sophisticated robotics and AI research. Sophia has gained international recognition, becoming the world's first robot citizen and the first robot Innovation Ambassador for the United Nations Development Programme. Her appearances on programs like "The Tonight Show" and "Good Morning Britain," as well as her participation in numerous global conferences, have made her a household name.

Sophia's AI integrates various technologies, including symbolic AI, neural networks, expert systems, machine perception, conversational natural language processing, adaptive motor control, and cognitive architecture. (19) . Her machine perception capabilities allow her to recognize human faces, interpret emotional expressions, and identify hand gestures, facilitating meaningful human-robot interactions. Sophia can assess human emotions during conversations and strives to collaborate effectively with users. She also possesses her own simulated emotions, modeled after human evolutionary psychology and different brain regions.

- (20) , Sophia features advanced motor control systems, including inverse kinematics solvers and path planning algorithms, which govern her hand movements, gaze, and locomotion. Her walking mechanism employs dynamic stabilization, allowing her to navigate various terrains. The integration of these AI components is managed through the Synthetic Organism Unifying Language (SOUL), a protocol developed by the Hanson-AI team. Preliminary assessments using the Tononi Phi measurement suggest that Sophia may possess a rudimentary form of consciousness, depending on (21)
- , it is important to recognize that no AI system, including hers, matches human intelligence. Consequently, her interactions are often supported by human developers—engineers, artists, and scientists—who guide her conversations and behaviors. This collaborative approach ensures that Sophia continues to evolve as a platform for exploring human-robot experiences in service and entertainment applications, contributing to the broader understanding of AI's potential and limitations.
