Tet, or Vietnamese Lunar New Year, is the most important festival in Vietnam, marking the arrival of spring and a fresh start. It is a time for family reunions, ancestor worship, and various traditions meant to bring good fortune. Before Tet, families clean their homes, decorate with peach or apricot blossoms, and prepare special foods. Markets become busy as people buy ingredients, new clothes, and gifts, creating a joyful atmosphere across the country.

Traditional foods play a key role in Tet celebrations, with *banh chung* (square sticky rice cake) and *banh day* (round sticky rice cake) symbolizing the Earth and sky. These foods are not only enjoyed during the holiday but also offered to ancestors as a sign of respect. Families gather to cook these cakes together, which **strengthens** bonds and preserves traditions. [I] In February 2025, the Houston Independent School District (HISD) joined a growing number of school districts in a lawsuit against major social media companies, including Meta, Snap, and ByteDance. [II] The lawsuit, filed in the U.S. District Court in California, alleges that these platforms are intentionally designed to maximize screen time and foster addictive behaviors among youth. [III] HISD, along with Cypress-Fairbanks ISD and Conroe ISD, has retained legal representation on a contingency basis, meaning the law firms involved will only be compensated if the case is won or settled favorably. [IV]

This legal action reflects a broader concern about the impact of social media addiction on young people's mental health. Recent observations by addiction specialists have highlighted that those addicted to technology and social media exhibit withdrawal symptoms **similar** to those experienced by substance abusers. For instance, Lee Fernandes, an addiction specialist at UKAT, has reported cases where individuals spend excessive amounts of time on platforms like YouTube - up to 15 to 17 hours daily - and experience symptoms such as shaking, sweating, and insomnia when attempting to reduce usage. These findings underscore the severity of social media addiction and **its** profound effects on individuals' well-being.

In response to these growing concerns, various initiatives have been **proposed** to mitigate the negative impacts of excessive social media use. One such initiative is "Phone-Free February," which encourages individuals to reduce screen time to improve tmental health, sleep quality, and productivity. Research indicates that high social media usage is linked to increased feelings of depression and self-comparison. Experts suggest that gradual steps, such as replacing screen time with activities like reading or engaging in hobbies, establishing screen-free zones, and utilizing app blockers, can help individuals manage their social media consumption more effectively.

Legislative measures are also being considered to address this issue. In Connecticut, a bipartisan group of lawmakers has expressed support for legislation aimed at restricting cellphone usage among children and teenagers, particularly concerning social media access. The proposed law, advocated by Attorney General William Tong, seeks to protect minors from technology addiction by implementing measures such as prohibiting social media use between midnight and 6 a.m. Also, this law requires companies to implement more robust age verification processes to ensure minors are adequately protected. These efforts aim to curb the rising rates of anxiety, depression, and other mental health issues associated with excessive social media use among the youth.

In July 2023, Meta launched Threads, a social media platform meant to compete with Twitter by allowing real-time conversations. The app quickly became popular, reaching over 100 million users within a week. However, as more people started using Threads, some behaviors from other social media platforms also appeared, making people question the authenticity of the content being shared. Some users began posting in a way that seemed overly dramatic or **exaggerated**, making their opinions sound more important than they actually were.

One common trend on Threads is "rage bait" posts, which are written in a way that makes people angry or emotional, encouraging them to leave comments. Journalist Katie Notopoulos tested this by posting things designed to make people react strongly, and she found that these posts got more attention because the platform's algorithm seemed to promote content with a lot of engagement. While this strategy helps posts go viral, it also raises concerns about whether people are sharing **genuine** thoughts or just trying to get noticed.

Threads has also become a place for spreading rumors and conspiracy theories. After the 2024 U.S. presidential election, some users started posting claims about election fraud. This created a lot of arguments and showed how difficult it is for social media platforms to control false information. Many people worry that these kinds of posts will make it harder to find accurate news and honest discussions.

The situation on Threads shows how hard it is to manage online communities. While the platform gives people a space to express **their** ideas, the rise of exaggerated posts and false information makes it difficult to know what is real. Unless Threads finds ways to encourage meaningful conversations, misleading or overly dramatic content will likely take over.

The additional funds from the proposed levy would provide a more consistent and secure financial foundation, enabling carers to continue **their** essential work without bearing the full financial burden themselves.

However, the proposal has sparked debate among the public. Some motorists express concern about the introduction of another charge to their registration fees, questioning why they should bear responsibility for wildlife care funding. Gibbard acknowledges this perspective but urges the community to recognize the invaluable service these volunteers provide. She highlights that without adequate support, many carers may be unable to continue their efforts, potentially leaving numerous animals without the necessary care and rehabilitation.

For the proposal to advance to parliamentary debate, it requires at least 10,000 signatures. Advocates are actively campaigning to gather support, believing that the modest fee is a small price to pay <u>for the welfare of</u> the region's wildlife. They argue that a collective contribution from motorists can

lead to substantial positive outcomes for animal rescue operations, ensuring that volunteers are not left to shoulder the financial strain alone.

In February 2025, former U.S. President Donald Trump announced a new rule to stop the use of paper straws in government buildings and return to plastic straws. This decision canceled a previous policy that tried to **minimize** single-use plastics, including straws, to help protect the environment. Trump argued that paper straws are weak, break easily, and do not work well with hot drinks. He also questioned whether plastic straws really harm the environment as much as people say.

The new rule tells all government offices to stop buying paper straws and replace **them** with plastic ones. It also requires officials to create a national plan to remove paper straws from public spaces. Supporters of this change believe paper straws are very **expensive**, less useful, and sometimes still come wrapped in plastic, making them less environmentally friendly. In contrast, some businesses that produce plastic products have welcomed the decision, arguing that it supports American manufacturing.

However, many environmental groups strongly disagree with this decision. <u>They say plastic straws</u> and other plastic waste pollute the ocean and harm marine animals. They also argue that the switch back to plastic straws ignores efforts to reduce waste and find better alternatives. This issue has started a bigger debate about how to balance convenience, business interests, and protecting the environment.

Trump's decision is part of a larger trend of changing environmental rules. It raises questions about whether protecting businesses or protecting nature should be a bigger priority. The debate over plastic and paper straws is just one small part of a larger conversation about how to take care of the planet.

One recent example is Portugal, where the government introduced a new policy in November 2024 to tackle the brain drain problem. The country has seen a large number of young professionals leaving for better-paying jobs in other European nations, which has negatively impacted its economy. To counter this, Portugal announced a ten-year tax break plan that offers young workers a 100% income tax exemption in their first year of employment, followed by gradually reduced exemptions over the next nine years. This initiative aims to make staying in Portugal more financially attractive for young professionals and encourage them to contribute to the country's economic development instead of seeking work abroad.

Similarly, in the United States, the Midwest has been struggling with a persistent brain drain as many college graduates move to bigger cities in search of better job opportunities. A report from February 2024 showed that many Midwestern and Great Plains states lost more educated residents than they gained in 2022. The main reason behind this migration is the lack of well-paying jobs, as well as limited career growth in many industries. This trend has raised concerns among policymakers, who fear that the continued loss of talent could weaken local economies and make it even harder to attract businesses and investments to these regions.

To address this issue, some cities have started taking action. In St. Louis, Missouri, Washington University commissioned a study in late 2024 to explore strategies for keeping more graduates in the area. The report emphasized that competitive salaries, affordable housing, and strong social connections play a crucial role in encouraging young professionals to stay. By focusing on these key factors, the city hopes to build a more attractive environment for skilled workers and prevent further talent loss. Other regions facing similar problems are also considering adopting similar measures, recognizing that retaining talent requires more than just job opportunities - it also depends on the overall quality of life in a given area.



Vietnam is undergoing rapid urbanization, with major infrastructure and development projects shaping the country's future. In November 2024, the National Assembly approved a high-speed railway connecting Hanoi and Ho Chi Minh City. In recent years, Vietnam has seen a significant number of university graduates, facing challenges in securing employment aligned with their fields of study. A report by the Ministry of Labour, Invalids and Social Affairs highlighted that annually, over 100,000 university graduates remain unemployed, with up to 60% accepting jobs unrelated to **their** majors. This trend underscores a growing **mismatch** between academic training and labor market demands, prompting many graduates to explore alternative career paths.

For instance, graduates with degrees in English have increasingly ventured into diverse sectors beyond traditional teaching roles. A study focusing on Vietnamese English-major graduates revealed that many have successfully transitioned into fields such as business, technology, and international relations. These individuals often leverage their language proficiency and critical thinking skills to adapt to various professional environments, highlighting the versatility of their academic background.

Additionally, the Vietnamese government has been proactive in addressing these employment challenges by promoting vocational training and international collaboration. **Notably, partnerships with countries like Germany have opened avenues for graduates in sectors such as nursing**. Such initiatives not only **alleviate** domestic employment pressures but also equip graduates with valuable skills applicable in global contexts.

[I] In October 2024, a significant study published in the International Journal of Epidemiology raised concerns about the health implications of standing desks. [II] These desks have become increasingly popular in modern workplaces. [III] Researchers from the University of Sydney conducted an extensive analysis involving over 83,000 British adults, tracking their health data over a period of seven to eight years. [IV]

The findings revealed that merely standing for extended periods does not confer the anticipated benefits for heart health. In fact, the research indicated that standing for more than two hours daily was associated with an 11% increase in the likelihood of developing circulatory problems, such as varicose veins and deep vein thrombosis, for every additional 30 minutes spent standing. This challenges the common perception that standing desks are a **straightforward** solution to the health risks posed by prolonged sitting.

Dr. Matthew Ahmadi, the lead author of the study, emphasized that while reducing sedentary behavior is essential, simply substituting sitting with standing is insufficient. He stated, "The key takeaway is that standing for too long will not <u>offset</u> an otherwise sedentary lifestyle and could be risky for some people in terms of circulatory health." This underscores the necessity of incorporating regular physical activity into daily routines rather than relying solely on standing as an alternative to sitting.

The study also highlighted that prolonged sitting remains a significant concern, with each additional hour beyond ten hours daily increasing the risk of cardiovascular diseases by 26%. Professor Emmanuel Stamatakis, a co-author of the research, suggested practical measures to reduce these risks, such as taking regular breaks, participating in walking meetings, and using stairs instead of elevators. He noted, "For people who sit for long hours, incorporating small movements throughout the day can make a significant difference in overall health."

In conclusion, while standing desks offer an alternative to traditional seating arrangements, this research indicates that they are not a panacea for the health issues associated with sedentary lifestyles.  $\underline{\mathbf{A}}$  balanced approach that combines reduced sitting time with increased physical activity appears to

<u>be more effective</u>. Employers and individuals should consider integrating movement and exercise into daily routines to address the multifaceted challenges of workplace health.
