Angela Merkel - The first female chancellor has governed Germany for almost 16 years. Now she is retiring. Now, let's have a look at her political career!

Angela Merkel was born in Hamburg on 17 July 1954. In 1991, Angela Merkel was selected as minister for women and youth. In 1994, Angela Merkel was appointed the minister for the environment, nature conservation and nuclear safety.

Then in 2005 Angela Merkel was chosen to be the first female chancellor in Germany's history. Merkel was re-elected for the first time in 2009, the second time in 2013 and the third time in 2018.

Joachim Sauer, a chemist, has been married to Angela Merkel since 30 December 1998. The couple only rarely appear in public together.

Her hand gesture, known as the Merkel diamond or the triangle of power, is typical of Angela Merkel.

Colorful blazers are one of Merkel's trademarks, which means she tends to be easy to spot on the group photos taken at international conferences. People often say that the color she wears each time might convey specific message.

Animals are not known to play any important part in Angela Merkel's private life. However, she did reply "I like animals" when asked by a member of the public in 2019.

This is a short talk about Vietnam's achievements in foreign affairs during international integration.

Firstly, Vietnam has established relations with 189 nations out of 193 member countries in The United Nations. International economic integration has witnessed many breakthroughs with more than 220 trade partners, and 71 countries recognize Vietnam's market economy status. Vietnam has also joined and has good relations with World Trade Organization (WTO), World Bank (WB) and Asia-Pacific Economic Cooperation (APEC).

Secondly, international position has been improved a lot. Vietnam was ASEAN Chairman in 2010 and 2020 and hosted APEC in 2006 and 2017.

Vietnam has basically built a land border of peace, friendship and cooperating with neighboring countries.

Thirdly, over the past 5 years, Vietnam has protected work for more than 50,000 citizens; 10, 000 fishermen and has organized about 800 flights to bring more than 200,000 citizens back home safely during COVID-19 pandemic.

Vietnam has received more than 151 million doses of COVID-19 vaccines and medical supplies. The country has also provided timely and effective medical and financial supplies to over 50 countries and international organizations
