About This Book

Welcome to *Now I Know My Colors, Shapes & Patterns Learning Mats*! The 104 double-sided mats in this book provide engaging activities designed to help children master essential early skills and concepts. In addition, the systematic format reinforces literacy and fine-motor skills while enabling children to work independently.

The interactive, reproducible mats feature appealing art and simple, predictable text that targets specific colors, shapes, and patterns. Activities include identifying eight different colors and shapes; reading and writing color and shape words; tracing, drawing, and matching shapes; and recognizing and creating basic patterns with colors, shapes, and symbols. The drawing and writing exercises help develop and strengthen fine-motor skills as well as reinforce shape, letter, and word recognition. And, as children read and follow directions to complete each mat, they build critical vocabulary and comprehension skills. To help meet the learning needs of your students, refer to page 8 to see how activities in this book connect to the Common Core State Standards for Reading (Foundational Skills), Language, and Mathematics, as well as to the standards recommended by the National Council of Teachers of Mathematics (NCTM).

Preparing and using the learning mats is quick and easy! Simply make double-sided copies to use for instruction with the whole class, small groups, student pairs, or individuals. The mats are also ideal for independent work, centers, and homework. You'll find that daily practice with these activities helps build and reinforce knowledge of basic concepts and boosts early literacy skills. Best of all, children will experience the joy of learning as they develop skills that help them grow into more confident, fluent readers.

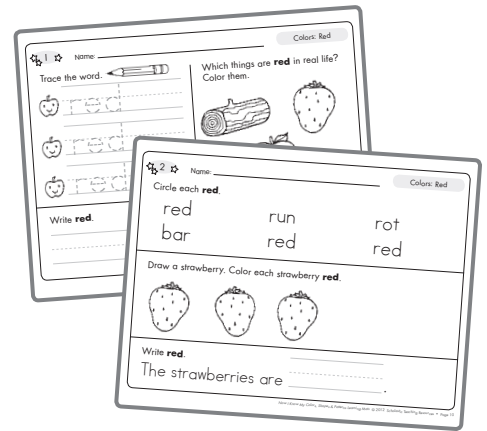
What's Inside

The learning mats in this resource are divided into three sections: Colors (mats 1–34), Shapes (mats 35–72), and Patterns (mats 73–104). Activities on each mat target a specific color, shape, or pattern. Review mats are also included to provide extra practice for each concept. Although a separate section is dedicated to patterns, activities that involve patterning with colors and shapes are found in those respective sections. Mats in the patterns section give children practice in recognizing, extending, and creating patterns with pictures and symbols (such as letters and numbers).

The mats are ready to use. Simply decide on the skill or topic you want to teach, locate the corresponding mats in the book, and make a double-sided copy of those mats. The only materials kids need for the activities are crayons or colored pencils. To use, children read and follow the directions to complete each activity. You'll find several activity formats throughout the book, as described on pages 6–7.

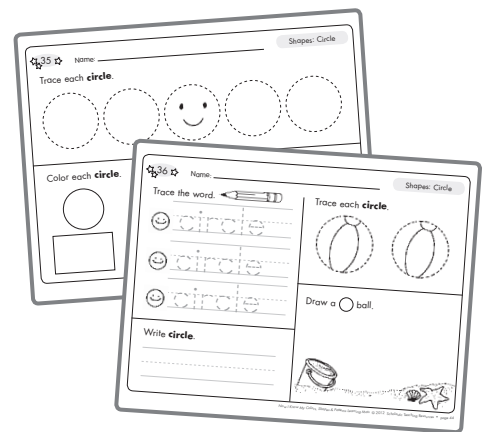
Colors

- ❖ **Trace and Write:** Children trace the target color word and then write the word on their own without guides. This exercise reinforces letter formation, word recognition, and spelling.
- ❖ **Identify Object Colors:** This activity lets children identify and color objects that are commonly found—in real life—in a specific color.
- ❖ **Identify the Word:** Children use visual discrimination skills to identify the target word from similarly spelled or shaped words.
- ❖ **Drawing:** This activity helps develop fine-motor skills while reinforcing the targeted color concept.
- ❖ **Fill-in-the-Blank:** Children use context by writing the target word in a sentence that connects to the art they drew in the previous activity.
- ❖ **Review:** Color-coded pictures help reinforce color word recognition and fine-motor skills. A writing activity offers additional practice in recognizing, spelling, and writing color words.
- ❖ **Color Patterns:** Children use a color key to create AB, AAB, ABB, AABB, and ABC patterns.



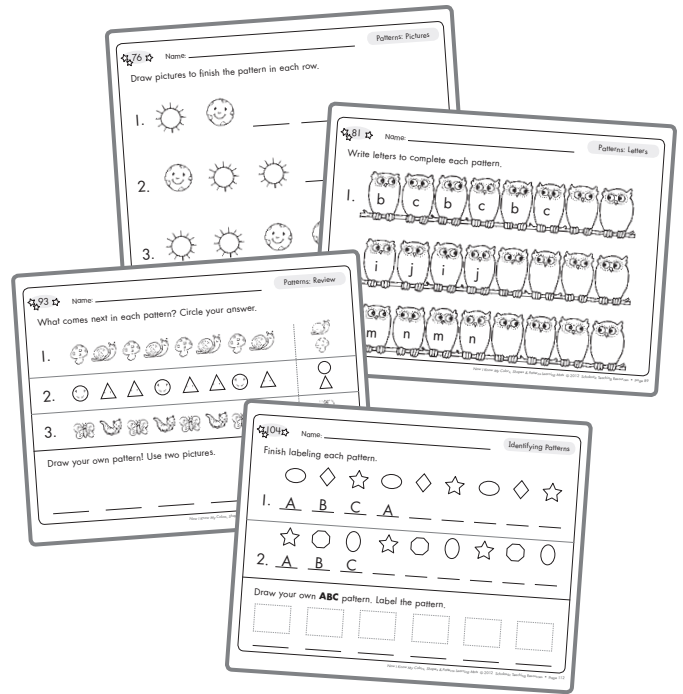
Shapes

- ❖ **Trace the Shape:** To develop shape recognition and fine-motor skills, children trace the target shape in two activities on these mats.
- ❖ **Identify the Shape:** Children identify the target shape from a variety of shapes and then color the appropriate ones.
- ❖ **Trace and Write:** In this activity, children trace the target shape word and then write the word on their own.
- ❖ **Drawing:** To target shape concepts and fine-motor skills, children draw a picture using a specific shape.
- ❖ **Review:** These color-coded pictures reinforce shape word recognition and fine-motor skills. A writing activity gives children more practice in recognizing, spelling, and writing shape words.
- ❖ **Shape Patterns:** Children draw shapes to complete AB, AAB, ABB, AABB, and ABC patterns.
- ❖ **Identify Attributes:** Activities on these mats help sharpen reasoning skills. Children color the shapes and then identify which shape matches the specific attributes stated in the directions.



Patterns

- ❖ **Complete the Patterns:** Children complete patterns by drawing pictures or filling in the missing letter or numbers. Each mat features a variety of patterns.
- ❖ **Review:** In these activities, children demonstrate understanding of patterns by identifying the item or shape that comes next in a pattern, as well as creating their own patterns.
- ❖ **Identify Patterns:** Children identify, label, and create their own AB, AAB, ABB, AABB, and ABC patterns.



Helpful Tips

The following suggestions will help you and your students get the most out of the learning mats:

- Complete each mat in advance to become familiar with the directions, art, and response for each activity. If desired, laminate your completed copy to use as an answer key. (Or slip the mat into a clear, plastic page protector.) You might bind all of your answer keys into a notebook to keep on hand for children to check their work.
- Use the mats to introduce new concepts, track children's progress in mastering essential skills, and review concepts already covered.
- Prepare the mats for repeated use in learning centers. Simply laminate the double-sided mats and put them in a center along with wipe-off color crayons and paper towels (to use as erasers).
- Compile sets of the learning mats into booklets for children to complete in class or at home. For example, you might staple copies of mats 1–6 between two sheets of construction paper and title the booklet, "My Red, Yellow, and Blue Book."
- The mats are also perfect for instant homework assignments. Send the pages home with children to complete. This is an easy way to reinforce skills covered in class, as well as to keep families informed about what their children are learning, what they've mastered, and where they might need some extra guidance.
