Cell phones are an **integral** part of our society and their main use is communication. They keep students in touch with the rest of the world by giving them the power to interact with it. In the old days, if you forgot your lunch, you were at the mercy of the office calling home for you. Cell phones also allow students to keep in touch with students at other schools or friends that don't go to school.
