The first thing is this – you need to be sure it's the job you really want to do. It requires lots of hard work and several years of study at universities before astronaut training even begins. Most people start between 27 and 37 years of age. Many astronauts also train to become pilots first.

Astronauts come from all over Europe and the world, and it's important that they can speak the same languages. They have to speak English, and they're given Russian lessons. Some also learn another language, for example Japanese, as a number of astronauts are Japanese speakers.

If you're still at school and you'd like to be an astronaut when you're older, it's not too early to start developing the skills you'll need. Playing video games is a great thing to do, as **it** helps you to think quickly and clearly. This is what you'll need to do when you travel in space.
