#### **Tet Holiday - Vietnam's Most Important Celebration**

After the celebrations, people return to work and school, feeling refreshed and hopeful for a prosperous year ahead. The values of Tet—family, gratitude, and renewal—make it a **cherished** tradition in Vietnamese culture.
