+ Câu kết luận: tóm tắt lại các ý vừa được nhắc đến trong đoạn.

Tuy nhiên, một số đoạn không có hoặc câu chủ đề hoặc câu kết.

• Nếu đoạn văn là câu chuyện thì hãy để ý đến trình tự thời gian.
