One of the most popular quiz programmes on television in the world is called *Who Wants To Be A Millionaire?* In Britain, the quizmaster is Chris Tarrant. He asks the contestants fifteen questions. The first questions are easy, but later, they are more **difficult**. If you can answer the fourteenth question, you can win £ 500,000. You can win a million pounds if you can answer the last question. Of course, the last question is very difficult.

All the questions on *Who Wants To Be A Millionaire?* are multiple-choice questions. After you hear the question, you see four answers. Only one answer is correct. You have to choose the correct answer.
