Sir Sterling Moss, a much-loved and <u>celebrated</u> former racing driver, passed away at the age of 90. Moss, who was widely acknowledged as one of the greatest drivers never to have won the Formula One world title, died at his London home in the early hours of Sunday morning following a long illness. Born in 1929, Moss was highly admired for his skill behind the wheel, having a remarkably successful career in sports car racing at the same time as F1.

Lewis Hamilton, a six-time Formula 1 world champion, was among many current and former drivers to pay tribute to the man. The three-time world champion Jackie Stewart, who collected Moss's autograph as a youngster and went on to become godfather to his son Elliot, said that Moss "walked like a racing driver should walk, he talked like a racing driver, he looked like a racing driver and he set a standard that I think has been unmatched since he retired."

Hamilton also added on Instagram: "I think it's important that we celebrate his incredible life and the great man he was. To be honest, it was such a unusual pairing, our friendship. Two people from massively different times and backgrounds, but we **clicked** and ultimately found that the love for racing we both shared made us comrades."

Many people admired Moss as a racer who enjoyed life to the full and embraced every aspect of a racing driver's lifestyle. He had a determination to take victory at every attempt, which he admitted was more important than titles. His former team Mercedes said on Twitter: "Today the sporting world lost not only a true icon and a legend, but a gentleman. The team and the Mercedes Motorsport family have lost a dear friend. Sir Stirling, we'll miss you."
