Using paper bags instead of plastic bags is a simple way to help our environment. Paper bags are better because they are made from trees, which can grow again. Plastic bags are made from oil, which is a resource that we cannot replace easily.

Paper bags can break down in nature. If a paper bag is left outside, it will become part of the earth again in a short time. This is called biodegrading. Plastic bags do not biodegrade easily. They can take hundreds of years to break down. This means they stay in the environment for a long time and can harm animals and plants.

Paper bags are also easy to recycle. Many places have special bins for recycling paper. When paper bags are recycled, they can be turned into new paper products. **This** saves trees and energy. Plastic bags are harder to recycle. Many recycling centers do not accept them because they can get stuck in the machines.

Using paper bags can also help reduce **litter**. When people throw plastic bags on the ground, they often end up in rivers, lakes, and oceans. This can hurt fish and other sea animals. Paper bags are less likely to cause this **issue** because they break down faster.

Everyone can help by choosing paper bags instead of plastic bags. Many stores offer paper bags, or you can bring your own. Some people even use cloth bags, which can be used many times and are even better for the environment.
