# How to use this book



Small children love looking at pictures and naming what they see. It can be even more fun if they share a word book with a grown-up. You could start by talking about what is going on in the big pictures. There will be many things that your child will recognize, as well as new objects to discuss.

On pages with small pictures around the edge, children will enjoy finding each image in the large picture. It is useful to talk about the colours and shapes they are looking for, as the scale of the object may be very different in each place.

Rhymes at the bottom of each page encourage children to look more closely at the pictures and to talk about their own experience. Finally, they are asked to find Teddy Bear (who appears on the cover of this book) wherever he is hiding!

As children gain confidence, they will enjoy finding objects throughout the book, not simply on one page. Later still, you could introduce them to the Word List at the back, showing them that it is organized alphabetically.

One of the best ways to help your child to enjoy books and reading is to show that you enjoy them too. We hope you both have fun with this book!
