Here are some tips on how to avoid and handle arguments with your parents:

Talk about the rules ahead of time and not at the last minute, so you'll be able to tell what your parents will say yes or no to before you make plans. Your parents can also explain to you why each rule is in place. Your parents may be willing to listen to your ideas and use them when making rules that you both agree on.

Spend time with your family. Communicate with each other and make some special family time. Suggest activities that your whole family will enjoy together include going for a hike, a bike ride, or going to the beach.
