

The Amazon Rainforest is the biggest tropical rainforest in the world. It covers about 40 percent of South America. This rainforest is very important because it has many kinds of plants and animals. People call it "the lungs of the earth" because it helps produce the oxygen we breathe.

The Birth of Seven Natural Wonders Seven Natural Wonders was created to celebrate and protect the original 7 Natural Wonders of the World. It's very important that these wonders are recognized because they are special, not because of money or business. A "Wonder" should be **amazing** on its own because of how different and important it is. The people who started Seven Natural Wonders knew that our world has many amazing places that could be called natural wonders. To recognize this, they started a project to find the top 7 natural wonders on each continent. These new wonders would be added to the original 7 Natural Wonders of the World. Their goal was to name the 7 Natural Wonders of Africa, Asia, Europe, North America, South America, and Oceania, which would add 49 new wonders to the list. They chose these places because they are very special and important. The group allowed the public to vote on the wonders, but each person could only vote one time. No one had to pay money or sponsor anything to vote. Experts from UNESCO and other groups, along with scientists and people who work in tourism, also helped to choose the wonders. **They** made sure to focus on how special each place was without any personal opinions. The public vote was important for two reasons. First, it was to see if people's choices were different from the experts' choices. Son Doong Cave

Son Doong Cave is famous for being the world's largest natural cave. It is full of interesting limestone features, including **grottoes**, stalactites, and stalagmites. The cave is located in Phong Nha-Ke Bang National Park, which is about 500 km south of Hanoi, Vietnam. If you like adventure, Son Doong Cave is a great place to visit during your holiday because it is one of Vietnam's natural treasures.

The cave was first found in 1991 by a local man named Ho Khanh. Later, in 2009, a group of British cavers led by Howard Limbert came to explore **it**. Son Doong Cave is very large, stretching 9 km long and reaching up to 200 meters high. This makes it about twice as big as the Deer Cave in Malaysia. Inside Son Doong Cave, you can see various animals like monkeys, bats, and flying foxes.
