Life on Other Planets

If there are living things on other planets, what are they like? Scientists who try to answer this question are called astrobiologists. Twenty years ago, life on other planets seemed impossible. Astronauts had visited the Moon and found no life on its surface. There were other reasons too: some planets are so cold that there can't be any life on them; on some others there is such heat that life is unthinkable there. Most planets have no water on the surface, and some planets have no atmosphere or they have a toxic atmosphere. However, in the 1990s scientists discovered some interesting species on our own planet, Earth. They discovered microbes living deep under the Earth's surface in temperatures of 160 degrees Celsius. They found worms that can live in ice, and deep-sea animals that eat only toxic chemicals. Scientists now think species like these may live on some other planets or moons, perhaps under the surface.
