Stephen Krashen is an American linguist and educator credited with the development of the Language Acquisition Theory. He was born in 1941 and **dedicated** all his life to studying the process of L2 acquisition. In fact, his hypothesis has greatly influenced thinking on language teaching, especially in ESL classes. Furthermore, Krashen places more emphasis on the natural approach in learning a language without much reliance on **rigid** grammar rules; hence, being more practical and friendly to learners.

Krashen has integrated five major hypotheses in his theory. Among them, the Acquisition-Learning Hypothesis maintains that people can only naturally acquire a language if they are exposed to it and it also states that children learned their first language. Learning, on the other hand, is a conscious process of studying the rules, though it is not effective as acquisition. The second is the Input Hypothesis, defined as an instance wherein the learner is exposed to an input somewhat beyond his or her current level of language knowledge, an i+1 level of understanding, to internalize and understand it better.

The third is the Monitor Hypothesis, which claims that conscious learning, such as grammar rules, is only useful in mistake correction rather than in attaining natural fluency. The Affective Filter Hypothesis pinpoints the learner's emotional system where "the more stressed, unmotivated, and anxious the students are, the less likely they will be to pick up language." Lastly, the Natural Order Hypothesis describes that people learn language structures in a predictable order independent of how they have been taught.

Krashen's ideas have really transformed the approach to language learning for many teachers. The theory allows a student to feel at ease in an environment with mainly natural communication and little pressure. Even nowadays, his works remain a cornerstone in modern language teaching and a source of inspiration for educators all over the world.

[I] Nestling within dynamic Balinese culture comes one of the world's most intriguing and peculiar events: Nyepi. The Balinese New Year, better known as Nyepi, doesn't involve parties or fireworks. [II] This follows with a deep silent day of self-meditation and spiritual cleansing [III]. It is a holy day, derived from the Saka Calendar, when the predominantly Hindu population of this island gets an opportunity to reunite with their inner self and their gods. [IV]

The preparation for Nyepi starts days in advance, with the execution of various colored and meaningful rituals. The most interesting include an Ogoh-Ogoh parade where huge and artistic statutes, which represent evil spirits, are taken along the streets. Made from bamboo and paper, these statues constitute both kinds of artistic work and forms of exorcising the island from all negative feelings. The Ogoh-Ogoh figures are ritually burned in a spectacular display as the sun is setting, a ritual that symbolizes destruction to evil spirits and spiritual rejuvenation.

But on Nyepi Day itself, the island is supposed to be in full **stillness**-no flights, no traffic, no lights, and no noise. Even tourists are encouraged to stay indoors and minimize activities by this convention. The streets are empty; it is a case whereby the island stood still, holding its breath. This silence amongst the Balinese people is an inside thing, deeply. They go into meditation, fasting, and reflection on life for a balance between good and evil in themselves. The silence is said to deceive the evil spirits that the island is indeed uninhabited, thus offering protection for the forthcoming year.

More than a religious holiday, Nyepi is deeply enriching in culture and spirituality, underlining the values of harmony and introspection particular to the Balinese. For any visitor, the experience of Nyepi is at once an exercise in humility and a source of inspiration. A stepping back from the din of modern life into the emotive power of silence, leaving with great respect for timeless traditions and the never-failing devotion of the people to beliefs.
